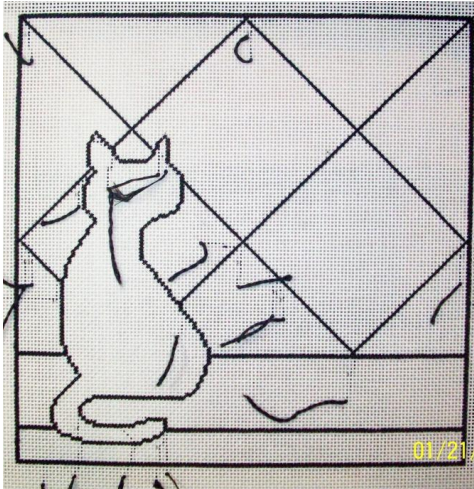


CAThedral

an original Needlepoint project from Blue Dogwood Designs

So you have your line drawn canvas. First step is to tent stitch the outline with black. Use floss or silk with a normal ply for your thread on 18 count.

If you are using "away knots" (like Linda W. did in the picture shown), keep the back drag thread away from the top right portion of the canvas. There will be lighter colors in that area. Looks messy, but so is life, it'll all be okay.

Or if you prefer: cover your start threads on the back and weave back in your stop threads. That works too.

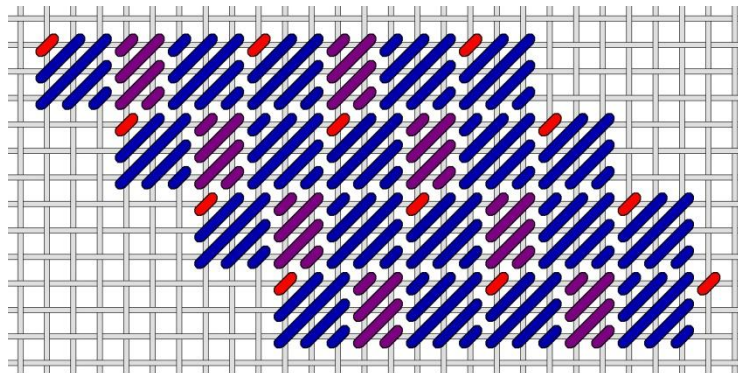
Just starting? Either draw your canvas from the instructions January 2013 Stitchguide or purchase a line drawn canvas for \$21 plus shipping.

Threads - These are the threads used, the Anchor Floss color match is in parenthesis.

Neon Rays N59	dark blue	(149)
Vineyard Silk 007	red	(47)
Perle Cotton #5 112	purple	(112)
